## 1. Counter Terrorism

RANZCO manages its risk related to terrorism via the guidelines of the Australian Anti-Terrorism Act (2001), and the New Zealand Terrorism Suppression Act (2002).

RANZCO will use its best endeavours to ensure that all expenditure of funds and implementation of program activities, including those carried out by any partners or affiliates in-country, comply with relevant Australian Government laws and regulations, including but not limited to:

- Those in relation to the proscription against providing direct or indirect support or resources to entities and individuals associated with terrorism, including:
  - 'Terrorist organisations' as defined in Division 102 of Part 5.3 of the Commonwealth Criminal Code Act 1995 and listed in regulation made under that Act; and
  - Regulations made under Part 4 of the Charter of the United Nations Act 1945.
- Those in relation to corrupt practices, in particular the bribery of public and foreign officials.

RANZCO will seek to comply with counter-terrorism laws and policies through assessment of all in-country partners to ensure there is no link with any entity or individual associated with terrorism. In this regard, at the commencement of any new relationship with another party, the General Manager Education and Development will be responsible for ensuring that the following websites are consulted and the outcome documented:
