Dr Tatham is an award winning cataract and glaucoma surgeon with a special interest in cataract surgery and all forms of glaucoma treatment.

He is a consultant at Princess Alexandra Eye Pavilion, Edinburgh and offers private appointments at The Edinburgh Clinic and Spire Shawfair Park. He provides a service personalised to the needs of individual patients and is ranked as one of the top 10 glaucoma specialists in Europe.

Dr Tatham is one of the few ophthalmologists to have completed two advanced training fellowships, graduating from Moorfields Eye
